

## Updated 05 June 2017

In light of the announced strike of the stevedores' sector in Spain, we would like to share with you the following information received from respective terminals and related with activities at gates.

This information applies to days when the strike is carried out that is:

- From 08:00 5th of June until 08:00 of 6th of June
- From 08:00 7th of June until 08:00 of 8th of June
- From 08:00 9th of June until 08:00 of 10th of June

Gates opening will be subjected to yard's congestion. Under this scenario regular opening timetable is not guaranteed.

### Algeciras TTIA

Day 05th of June Gates will open earlier at 02:00 to facilitate operations.

### Algeciras APMT

Gates will open days 05/07 & 09 during hours strike is not called.

**Bilbao Noatum**

Gates will open 15 to 30 minutes before regular gate opening time till 18:00.

Gates will be only opened for import units (including empty deliveries) / reefer / IMO.

Export in Noatum Bilbao will be accepted only for vessels operating same day.

Any allowance to enlarge the previous restriction for export cargo will be noticed after Monday 5th June.

Train operations will be limited to 20 hrs.

In order to mitigate the impact on non-strike days, they would consider the possibility to extent the timetable for delivery/reception of the containers from 20 to 02, subject to availability of dockers and conditions after the strike day. In case of train, depending on door's demand and congestion.

**Barcelona Best**

Day 05th of June is local holiday

So far no restrictions will be imposed at gate in terms of acceptance/releasing conts

**Barcelona APMT**

Export Cargo/Containers to be loaded shall only be accepted whenever are in the Terminal within the following time frame: not earlier than 5 Working Days from the start of the scheduled vessel's operations, and not later than 6 hours prior to the start of the scheduled operations of the vessel.

**Valencia Noatum**

Gates will open at 07:45 till 18:00

Train operations will be limited to 20 hrs.

For non-strike days, gate operations will be extended till 23:00 subject to availability of dockers and conditions after the strike day.

**MSC Terminal Valencia**

Gates will open at 06:00 (instead at 08:00)

Days 06th of June and 8th of June gates will be extended till 23:00

## **Vigo Termavi**

During conflict days, gates will be open 15 minutes in advanced (07:45 hours). For these days, closing time will be at 18:45 hours. Priority will be granted for reefer conts and IMO cargo.

We inform you that based on the communications released, the unions have decided to keep the call for strikes on days 5 June, 7 June and 9 June.

## **Updated 24 May 2017**

We inform you that based on official communications, the unions responsible for calling strikes on 12th May have agreed on the suspension of them on the following dates: 24th May, 26th May, 29th May, 31st May and 2nd June, keeping the call on 5th June, 7th June and 9th June.

## **Updated 19 May 2017**

## Updated 16 May 2017

In light of the announced voting on the new port labour law in Spain, we have been advised of new industrial actions announced by the stevedores' union in Spanish ports. Slow-down actions on terminal operations have been initiated at the ports of Algeciras, Valencia and Barcelona from 14.00 on Monday, 15th May. In addition, official strikes have been announced in all Spanish ports in the form of work stoppages on every other hour, (starting at 8.00 on a specific day and lasting until 8.00 the following day) on the following dates: 24th May, 26th May, 29th May, 31st May, 2nd June, 5th June, 7th June and 9th June.

We are currently assessing what impact these actions will have on our operations and are committed to sharing more information with you as soon as possible.
